Farewell Assembly





Parent Consultation Meetings - Virtual

We would like to inform all parents, guardians and carers of the upcoming changes to Parent Consultation meetings in January 2022. We will be offering virtual Parent Consultation appointments via your child's Microsoft Teams login on Tuesday 4th and Wednesday 5th January.

This will ensure that you can discuss your child's progress with the teacher in a coronavirus-secure way. If your child has Special Educational Needs, you will be asked to meet the teacher face-to-face so that your child's Individual Education Plan (IEP) can be further discussed and signed. You should have received a letter with your allocated time slot and further relevant information.

Year 6 Parent Workshop

All parents, guardians and carers are invited to attend a Year 6 SATs workshop on Wednesday 12th January at 9:15am in the Hall. During the workshop, we will share strategies and ideas that could be used at home to support your child's learning. It will be an informative workshop and it is highly recommended that you attend. It will also give you opportunities to ask any questions regarding the Year 6 curriculum and assessments. We are looking forward to seeing you all and please ensure you wear a mask.

Primary School Admissions 2022

We would like to inform all parents, guardians and carers of children born between 1st September 2017 and 31st August 2018 that the closing date for applications for Primary School places to be received by the London Borough of Hillingdon, by post or online, is midnight on **Saturday 15th January 2022**. To ensure your application arrives on time and in order to give your child the best possible chance of being offered the school of your choice, we would advise that you submit your applications prior to the Christmas holiday period. The London Borough of Hillingdon states on their website that they cannot be held responsible for any delays in applications due to problems with postal or Internet service providers.
