The children participated in discussions about keeping safe on the road and they demonstrated how to 'Stop! Look! and Listen!' In the playground, the teachers drew a road and zebra crossing for the children to practise. Little Acorns learnt what zebra crossings are used for and when should they be used. The children assumed different roles as motorists and pedestrians which they enjoyed very much.



Anti-Bullying Week – One Kind Word



Anti-Bullying Week was observed from Monday 15th to Friday 19th November under the theme One Kind Word. The children were challenged each day to think of one kind word that had to be shared with their friends and class mates in an effort to lift their spirits. Some classes placed special emphasis on the 'one kind word' by highlighting it on a placard which was constantly showcased in class as a reminder that one kind word can provide a moment of hope and break the cycle of bullying.

Each week in general assembly and in class, the children are encouraged to follow through with the anti-bullying theme so that all children will feel safe and happy in school through our 'one kind word' campaign.
