
















Applying for Secondary School September 2022

We would like to inform all parents, guardians and carers of children born between 1st September 2010 and 31st August 2011 that the closing date for applications for Secondary School places to be received by the London Borough of Hillingdon, by post or online, is **Sunday 31st October 2021**. To ensure your application arrives on time and in order to give your child the best possible chance of being offered the school of your choice, we would advise that you submit your applications no later than Friday 22nd October to ensure that it is received by the published deadline. You can apply for your child's secondary school at [https://archive.hillingdon.gov.uk/secondary]. You will receive information with regard to applying for your child starting secondary school shortly.

Primary School Admissions 2022

We would like to inform all parents, guardians and carers of children born between 1st September 2017 and 31st August 2018 that the closing date for applications for Primary School places to be received by the London Borough of Hillingdon, by post or online, is midnight on **Saturday 15th January 2022**. To ensure your application arrives on time and in order to give your child the best possible chance of being offered the school of your choice, we would advise that you submit your applications prior to the Christmas holiday period. The London Borough of Hillingdon states on their website that they cannot be held responsible for any delays in applications due to problems with postal or Internet service providers. Education Catch-Up

The government announced funding to support children and young people in England, in catching up on learning lost during the pandemic. With an ambitious education recovery plan, the various catch-up programmes and fun activities include catch-up sessions and support for Early Years, children and young people aged between 4 and 19, Special Educational Needs and Disability (SEND) support as well as mental health support.

Free School Meals - Application Process

'Free School Meals' is a statutory means-tested benefit, which provides a child with meals at school for free. If you believe your child may be newly entitled to this benefit, or if they received it last year and you would like to reapply, please attend the School Office and request an application form. The School Office will also be able to advise any parents, guardians or carers who are unfamiliar with the process for claiming 'Free School Meals'. The Free School Meals benefit does not automatically renew; it must be reapplied for each academic year. It is important to note that until your child has been confirmed as receiving the Free School Meals benefit, their school lunches must be paid for.

As a school, we will explore who Roald Dahl was and why he was so famous. The children are also encouraged to bring in their favourite Roald Dahl books from home to share with their friends.

Instrumental Assembly

On Monday 20th September, Hillingdon Music Hub will be hosting a special assembly for pupils in Years 4 and 5 in the hall. The objective of this assembly is to encourage more pupils to appreciate music to the extent where they have a strong desire to learn to play an instrument such as the guitar or keyboard, or participate in other available lessons. These lessons are usually conducted on our school site during the day once we have received consent and payment from the pupil's parents, guardians or carers.

Reception Pick Up

Parents, guardians and carers, please be aware that all the Reception children (Blossom and Cherry classes) will be dismissed at 1:30pm until Friday 17th September and will have lunch at school. If they are having hot dinners, please pre-order on iPay; otherwise, they should bring in a healthy packed lunch. The week beginning Monday 20th September, all children will be dismissed at 3:15pm throughout the year. Please make every effort to collect your child on time from the front entrance, where they will be dismissed.

Precautionary Measures for Coronavirus

Please note that although it is not mandatory, it will still be highly recommended for parents, guardians and carers to wear face masks and observe social distancing guidelines when on the School premises, and for children to perform regular handwashing throughout the day. In addition to these precautionary measures, the School are also anticipating the provision of the new carbon dioxide monitors this September launched by the government. The programme will provide sufficient monitors to take readings from across indoor spaces within the School to allow staff to identify where ventilation needs to be improved and let fresh air in, therefore removing air that contains virus particles and reducing the transmission of COVID-19.
