












Dancing Dynamites

Summer School will be free for pupils who are eligible for Free School Meals (some parents, guardians and carers who receive this benefit from the government). Thank you to all the parents, guardians and carers who completed the electronic form via text message last week.

All parents, guardians and carers that signed up would have received a letter confirming their activities and should have made full payment. If payment was not made, your booked slot would have been automatically cancelled.

Parent Consultation Meetings for September

Parent consultation meetings will be held over a two-day period for the new academic year – Wednesday 1st and Thursday 2nd September. We have split the meetings across both days to ensure social distancing is possible. Parent consultation times can be found on the letter sent out with the end of year reports.
