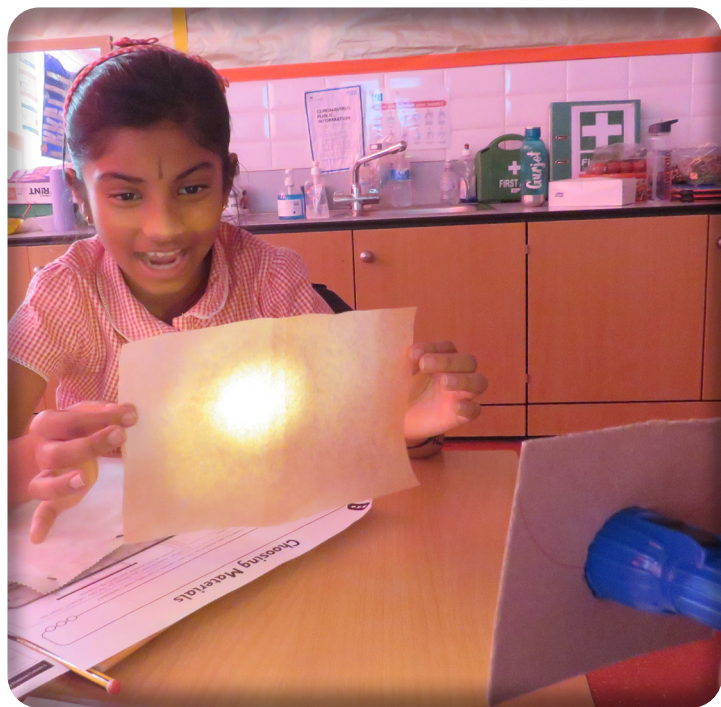


Quadkids Athletics



On Thursday 8th July, children in Years 5 and 6 participated in Hillingdon Primary Schools' Athletic Quadkids competition at the Hillingdon Leisure Centre in Uxbridge. In the spirit of competition and fair play, the children competed among other schools in a positive atmosphere whilst adhering to competition code of conduct. Each athlete was placed in a pool and competed in four rotational sequence of events ranging from 75 metres Sprint, 600 metres Run, Mini Vortex Howler Throw and Standing Long Jump. All the children participated well and welcomed the opportunity to show off their athletic prowess whilst competing against other schools.

Investigating How Shadows are Formed



On Tuesday 6th July, the Year 3 children looked at different materials (upholstery fabric, cotton, cling film, blackout curtain lining, grease paper, net curtain) to investigate how well each one blocks light by shining a torch onto it and seeing if it makes a dark shadow. They discovered that shadows are formed when the light from a light source is blocked by a solid object, enabling them to identify the best material for curtains for a baby's bedroom.



School Reports and Other Information

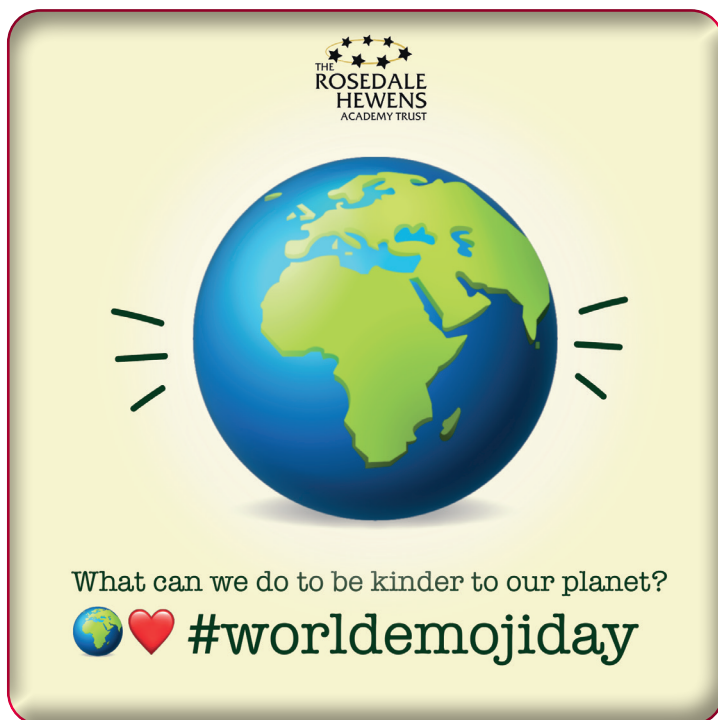
Please note that all children will be given their school reports, parent consultation time and other important information on the last week of term. It is very important your child is in school to avoid missing out on any vital information.
