Multiplication Tables Check – *Year 4*

On Monday 21st to Friday 25th June, the Year 4 children will be taking their Multiplication Tables Check (MTC) at school, which becomes statutory in September 2021.

The MTC is a Key Stage 2 assessment to be taken by pupils at the end of Year 4 in June. It is an online test where pupils are asked 25 questions on times tables from 2 to 12. For every question, pupils will have 6 seconds to answer and in between the questions, there is a 3 second rest. The questions are generated randomly based on the rules of the MTC, however, questions about the 6, 7, 8, 9, and 12 times tables come up more often.

The purpose of the MTC is to ensure pupils' times tables knowledge is at the expected level.

Parents, guardians and carers are being asked to ensure that the children practise on Times Tables Rock Stars (TTRS) which will be of great benefit in preparing them for the Multiplication Tables Check. We suggest practising 10 to 15 minutes a day for optimal results.

Wrap Around Care - Cash Payments: Please be advised that after trialling iPayimpact for our wrap around care provision, unfortunately, it has not been functioning as intended. As such, we have now reverted back to cash payments only as previously done for Breakfast Club and After School Care. Wrap Around Care

We are extremely proud that we have managed to keep our school open throughout all national lockdowns, and support key workers by providing free of charge care before and after school. This has been provided on a voluntary basis by our staff, in order to ensure our parents, guardians, carers and children have been supported as much as possible.

As we now move out of national restrictions, we need to return to ways of working which will ensure the viability of this provision. Therefore, wrap around care is no longer free of charge and payments must be made in cash.

All parents, guardians and carers who would like to make use of our wrap around care provision will be charged as follows:

- Breakfast Club: **7:45am** to staggered start time, **£1 per day, per child** which includes toast and squash.
- After School Club: staggered end time to **5:30pm**, **£6 per day, per child**, (which includes a snack of half a sandwich, a piece of fruit and a drink).

If you would like your child to attend Wrap Around Care, please let us know what days you would like for breakfast and after school care as soon as possible by picking up a form at the School Office.
