All pupils who participate in this activity by coming up with their innovations will be awarded 15 Alliance points and a STEM award certificate for participation.

In addition, there will be various school competitions such as Science Spelling Bee, Debates, Poster competitions and School's Challenge Quiz. Lots of awards, Alliance points and certificates to be won, so get involved! Information about these competitions will be posted in your class on Microsoft Teams.
