### Superhero Day





### Multiplication Tables Check – Year 4

Up until Friday 16th June, the Year 4 pupils will be taking their Multiplication Tables Check (MTC) at school. The MTC is a Key Stage 2 assessment to be taken by pupils at the end of Year 4 in June. It is an online test where pupils are asked 25 questions on times tables from 2 to 12. For every question, pupils will have 6 seconds to answer and in between the questions, there is a 3-second rest. The questions are generated randomly based on the rules of the MTC, however, questions about the 6, 7, 8, 9, and 12 times tables come up more often.

The purpose of the MTC is to ensure pupils' times tables knowledge is at the expected level. Parents, guardians and carers are being asked to ensure that the children practise on Times Tables Rock Stars (TTRS) which will be of great benefit in preparing them for the Multiplication Tables Check. We suggest practising 10 to 15 minutes a day for optimal results.

### Assessment and Phonics Screening Week

Assessment and Phonics Screening Week will take place from Monday 12th to Friday 16th June. Therefore, it is extremely important that your child attends school every day and arrives on time. This will assist us further to identify and address any gaps in the children's learning.

Please also remember that a good breakfast is always an essential meal for children before school, but in particular when they are sitting tests. Research has shown that children who eat a healthy breakfast have improved alertness, concentration, mental performance, mood and memory.

### Last Days of Enrichment Clubs

Please be aware that next week will be the final week of Enrichment Clubs for the Summer Term. Therefore, the final clubs will be held on Wednesday 14th and Thursday 15th June. Thank you.
