Black History Month - October 2023

Black History Month in the UK is a time to recognize and celebrate the contributions and achievements of Black people throughout history. It is an opportunity to learn about the rich and diverse history of the Black community, including their contributions to culture, politics, science and many other fields. It is a chance to highlight the importance of inclusivity and diversity. First brought to the UK in the 1980s, Black History Month was initially introduced to the country by a member of the Greater London Council, Akyaaba Addai Sebo. Since 1987, Black History Month has been celebrated annually in the UK, to eradicate discrimination and encourage racial equality. At Hewens Primary School, we will be honouring the contributions made to society by people of Black heritage and their communities. On Friday 20th, we will host a special celebration assembly at 2:00pm in the Quad Area to commemorate Black History Month.
