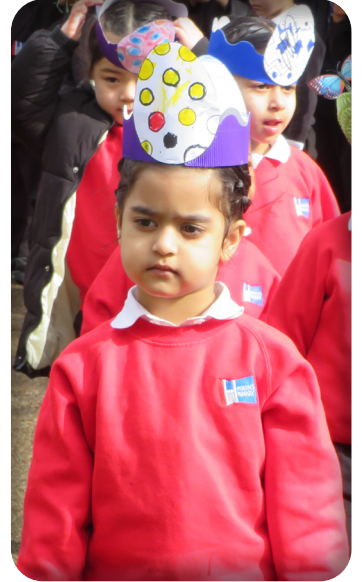


Easter Bonnet Showcase
