Multiplication Tables Check National Final

From over 1,000 schools which entered Emile's Year 4 Multiplication Tables Check (MTC) Cup, Hewens Primary reached the final with 29 other schools. Within the final, our pupils managed to get a total of 31,809 correct answers with an average percentage of 92%. Such speed and accuracy enabled us to place 10th. We also had seven pupils within the top 50 with the amount of correct answers. Well done to all the pupils who took part!
