## Great Plague and Fire of London Workshop

They explored the roles of key figures such as Samuel Pepys and King Charles II, and learnt about their contributions during the fire. The workshop also explained the impact of the plague and enhanced the pupils' understanding of the period's challenges. Through interactive activities, the pupils discovered the origins of the nursery rhyme "Ring a Ring o' Roses," linked to the plague. This hands-on experience brought history to life, fostering a deeper appreciation of the past and its significant events.
