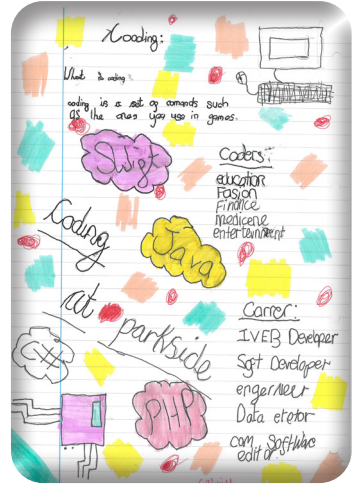
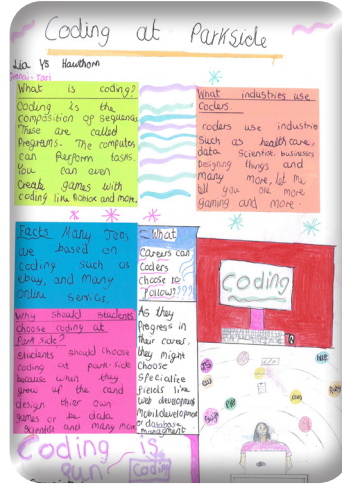
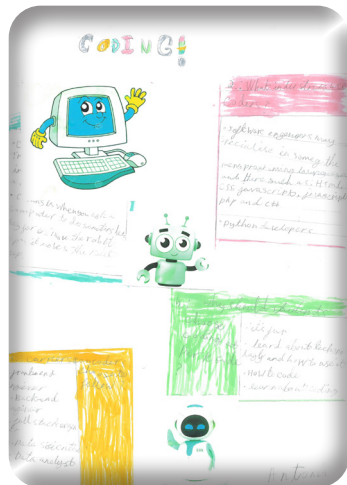
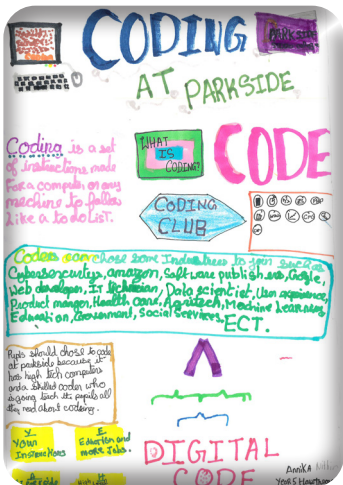
Cricket Carousel

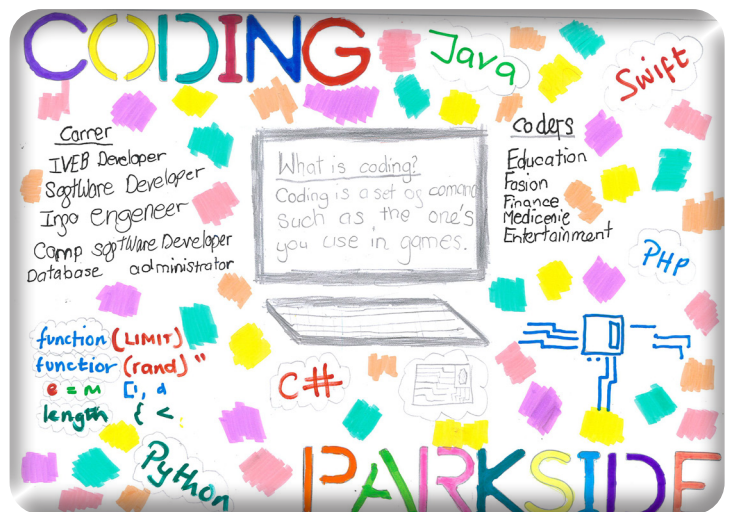
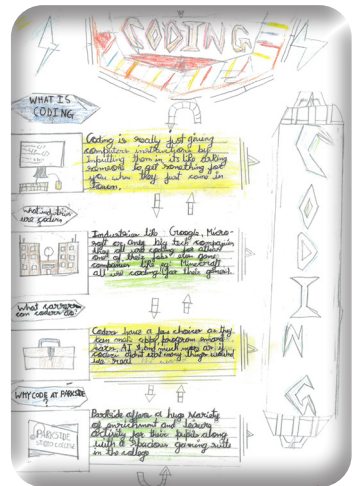
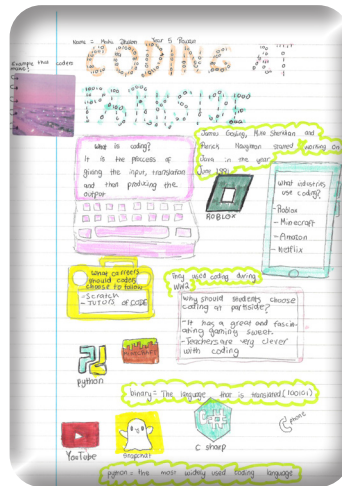
Coding Winners

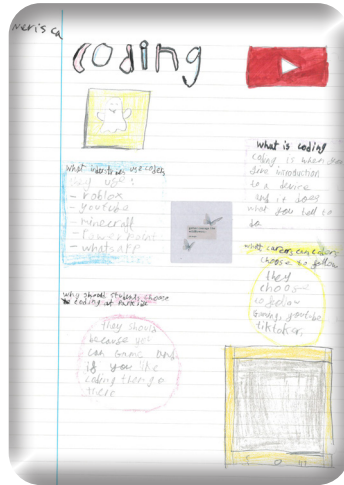
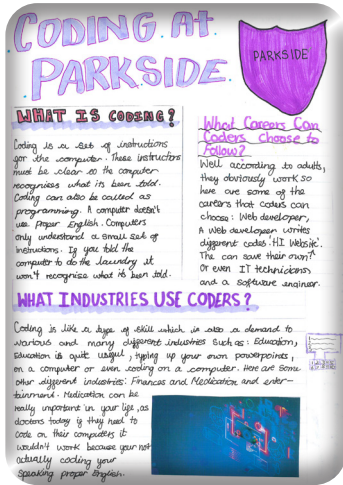


Last month, the Year 5 pupils took part in a Coding Poster Competition in the hope of winning a spot on a Coding Project set up with Parkside Studio College.
