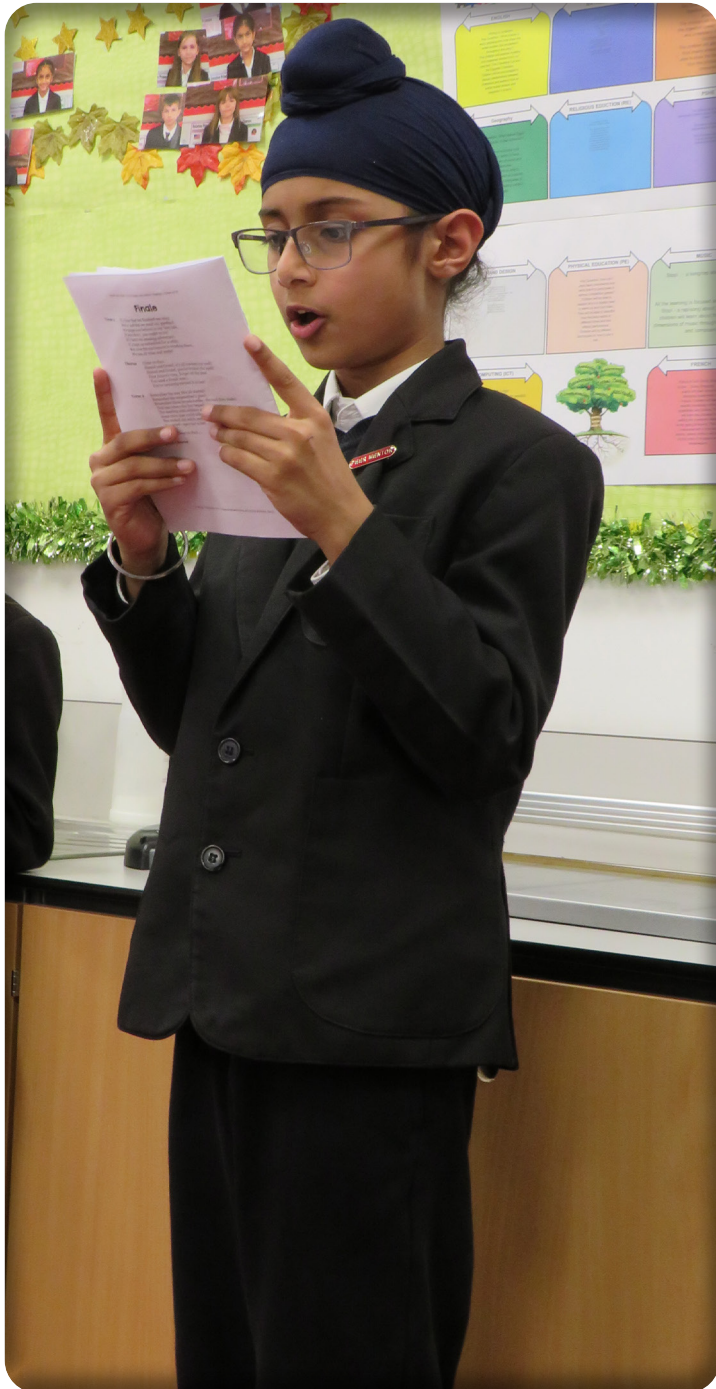
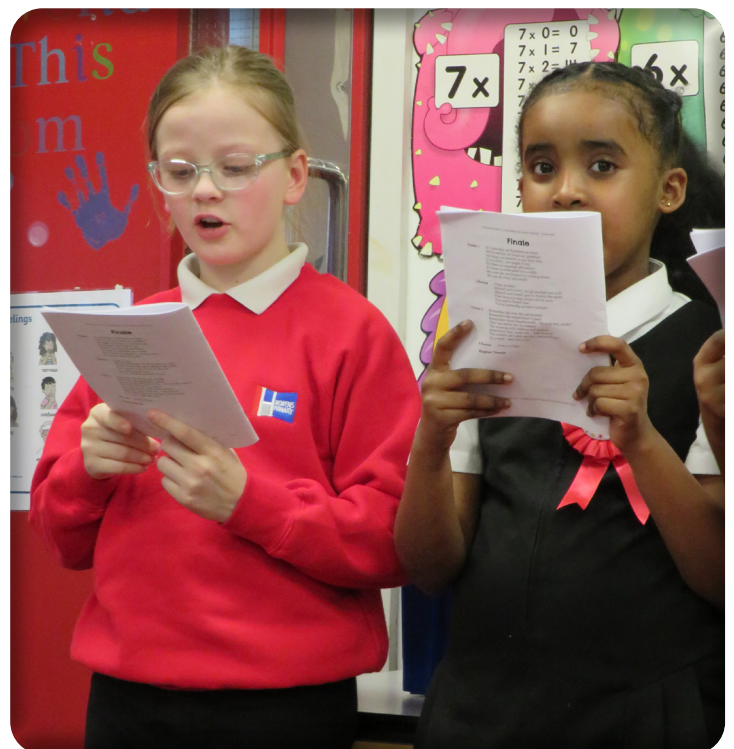


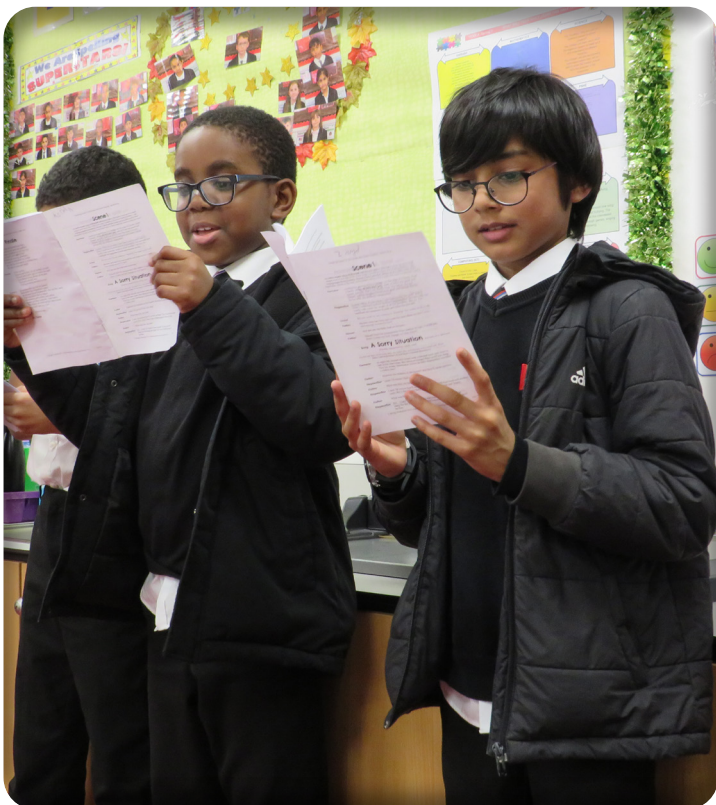


Drama Auditions
