Year 4 Science Experiment



On Tuesday 4th February, our Year 4 super scientists conducted an experiment to investigate whether sugary drinks cause tooth decay. They used eggs to represent teeth, as the shell of an egg is composed of a substance similar to tooth enamel. The eggs were placed in various drinks, including water, and left in a safe place for several days. The pupil scientists then recorded their observations and determined whether their predictions were correct. Overall, it was an informative and enjoyable experience!





Plants - What can you see?



The pupils in Year 3 explored how water is transported in plants through the tiny tubes in the stem to the tip. Using hand lenses, they observed the inside of a cut celery stem before placing it into a beaker with a food colouring mixture. Over time, they will observe the plant and record changes. This experiment helps them understand how plants absorb and distribute water to survive.
