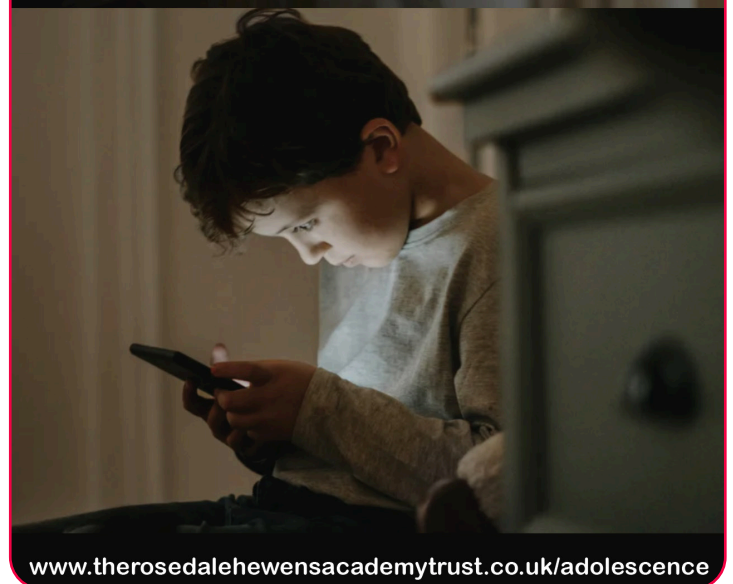
National Numeracy Day – Wednesday 21st May
