## Social Media - A Reminder About Safety and Age Restrictions

As a school, we are committed to the safety and wellbeing of all our pupils, both in school and at home. Please be aware that most social media platforms (e.g. Instagram, Snapchat, TikTok, WhatsApp) require users to be **at least 13 years old** due to risks such as inappropriate content, online bullying, and contact with strangers.

### Key Reminders:

- Most platforms require users to be ages 13 or over.
- Unsupervised use can expose children to harm.
- Online actions can have legal and emotional consequences.
- Parents, Guardians and Carers should regularly monitor and guide internet use.

Please talk with your child about safe online behaviour, check privacy settings, and report any concerning content. It is also important to remind children that what they post or share online can have real-world consequences, including legal ones in certain situations. ## Multiplication Tables Check - Year 4

Up until Friday 13th June 2025, the Year 4 pupils will be taking their Multiplication Tables Check (MTC) at school, which became statutory in September 2021. The MTC is a Key Stage 2 assessment to be taken by pupils at the end of Year 4, every June. It is an online test in which pupils are asked 25 questions covering times tables from 2 to 12. For each question, pupils will have 6 seconds to answer, with a 3-second pause between questions. The questions are generated randomly based on the rules of the MTC, however, questions about the 6, 7, 8, 9, and 12 times tables come up more often. The purpose of the MTC is to ensure pupils' times tables knowledge is at the expected level. Parents, guardians and carers are being asked to ensure that the children practise on Times Tables Rock Stars (TTRS) which will be of great benefit in preparing them for the Multiplication Tables Check. We recommend practising 10 to 15 minutes a day for optimal results.

## Phonics Screening Week - Year 1

Phonics Screening Week will take place from Monday 9th to Friday 13th June 2025. Therefore, it is extremely important that your child attends school every day and arrives on time. Please also remember that a good breakfast is always essential for children, especially when they are sitting tests. Research has shown that children who eat a healthy breakfast have improved alertness, concentration, mental performance, mood and memory.

## Last Days of Enrichment Clubs

Please be aware that next week will be the final week of Enrichment Clubs for the Summer Term. Therefore, the final clubs will be held on Wednesday 11th and Thursday 12th June 2025. Thank you.
