### Aims of the History Club:

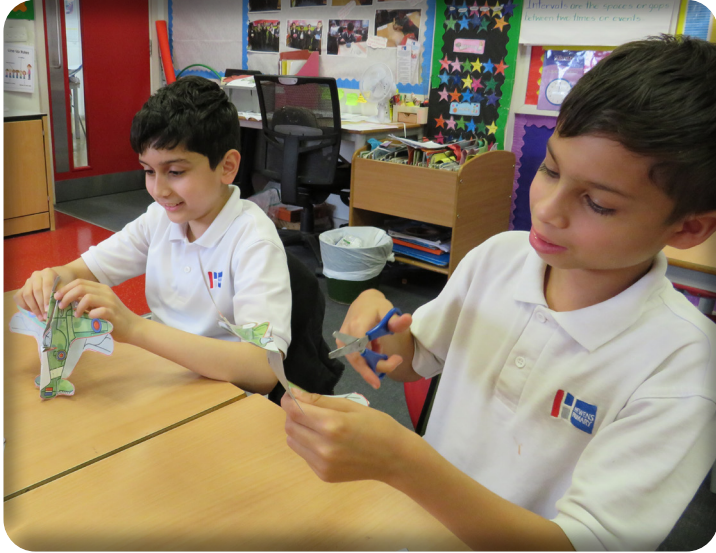
- To ignite a passion for the past through hands-on learning and exploration.

### Multiplication Tables Check – Year 4

Up until Friday 20th June 2025, the Year 4 pupils will be taking their Multiplication Tables Check (MTC) at school, which became statutory in September 2021. The MTC is a Key Stage 2 assessment to be taken by pupils at the end of Year 4, every June. It is an online test in which pupils are asked 25 questions covering times tables from 2 to 12. For each question, pupils will have 6 seconds to answer, with a 3-second pause between questions. The questions are generated randomly based on the rules of the MTC, however, questions about the 6, 7, 8, 9, and 12 times tables come up more often. The purpose of the MTC is to ensure pupils' times tables knowledge is at the expected level. Parents, guardians and carers are being asked to ensure that the children practise on Times Tables Rock Stars (TTRS) which will be of great benefit in preparing them for the Multiplication Tables Check. We recommend practising 10 to 15 minutes a day for optimal results.

### Sports Day

During the week commencing Monday 16th June 2025, Hewens Primary will be hosting our annual Sports Days. On Tuesday 17th June, we will be hosting our Nursery to Year 2 Sports Day and on Wednesday 18th June, we will be hosting our Years 3 to 6 Sports Day. All Sports Days will be held at Hewens College field and all parents are welcome to come and watch. Please see further information below for allocated times.
