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

## Safeguarding our Children

Please can all parents, guardians and carers be mindful of the safeguarding aspects for drop off and collection times. Please ensure you keep your child/ children with you at all times when outside the School court yard to avoid any incidents.

#### Headlice

We would like all parents to be aware we have recently had a number of cases regarding head lice. We would like to take this opportunity to remind you of the procedure for when to keep your child at home and when it is appropriate to send them back to school, should you suspect your child has head lice. We suggest that you check your child's head as soon as possible. If you suspect your child has head lice, please seek advice from a pharmacist that can assist you with the appropriate treatment. Once your child's hair is treated, they are able to attend school. Children's absence during term time will only be approved in exceptional circumstances. We would like to inform all parents, guardians and carers of children born between 1st September 2018 and 31st August 2019 that the closing date for applications for Primary School places to be received by the London Borough of Hillingdon, by post or online, is midnight on **Sunday 15th January 2023**.

To ensure your application arrives on time and in order to give your child the best possible chance of being offered the school of your choice, we would advise that you submit your applications prior to the Christmas holiday period. ## Wrap Around Care

• Breakfast Club: 7:45am to staggered start time, £1 per day, per child which includes toast and squash.

• After School Club: staggered end time to 5:30pm (prompt), £6 per day, per child, which includes a snack, sandwich, piece of fruit and a drink.
