# **Holiday Requests During Term Time**

Children's absence during term time will only be approved in exceptional circumstances. Any planned term time leave of absence, must be requested in writing to the Headteacher prior to any travel arrangements being made. ### Wrap Around Care

We would like to remind families that our Wrap Around Care service is a charged service we offer for working parents, guardians and carers. Those who would like to make use of our wrap around care provision will be charged as follows:

Breakfast Club: 7:45am to staggered start time, £1 per day, per child which includes toast and squash.

**After School Club:** staggered end time to 5:30pm (prompt), £6 per day, per child, which includes a snack, sandwich, piece of fruit and a drink.
