

#### Applying for Secondary School September 2023

We would like to inform all parents, guardians and carers of children born between 1st September 2011 and 31st August 2012 that the closing date for applications for Secondary School places to be received by the London Borough of Hillingdon, by post or online, is **Monday 31st October 2022**. To ensure your application arrives on time and in order to give your child the best possible chance of being offered the school of your choice, we would advise that you submit your applications no later than Friday 21st October to ensure that it is received by the published deadline. You can apply for your child's secondary school at [https://www.hillingdon.gov.uk/secondary]. You will have received information with regard to applying for your child starting secondary school Office.
