






WWII Workshop

Due to the high level of interest for Wrap Around Care, we have had to implement some changes to ensure we are able to continue offering the service. The following changes are:

- Breakfast Club will begin at 7:45 to 8:30am. 8:15am will be the cut-off time to arrive for Breakfast Club. If you arrive after this time, you will have to wait for the main doors to open at 8:30am.
- After School Care will begin straight after school at 3:30 to 5:30pm.
