Sock in the Box Challenge

For the first week back after the half term, we would like to ask all children to bring in a pair of clean socks. This will enable your class to take part in the challenge; any kind of socks will do but the more colourful, the better.

We hope you are ready for the challenge!

Half Term

School will be closed from Monday 30th May to Friday 3rd June for the Half Term holiday. School opens again on Monday 6th June at the normal staggered times. It is essential that your child arrives on time as lessons will begin promptly.

Multiplication Tables Check - Year 4

On Monday 6th to Friday 24th June, the Year 4 children will be taking their Multiplication Tables Check (MTC) at school, which became statutory in September 2021. The MTC is a Key Stage 2 assessment to be taken by pupils at the end of Year 4 in June. It is an online test where pupils are asked 25 questions on times tables from 2 to 12. For every question, pupils will have 6 seconds to answer and in between the questions, there is a 3 second rest. The questions are generated randomly based on the rules of the MTC, however, questions about the 6, 7, 8, 9, and 12 times tables come up more often. The purpose of the MTC is to ensure pupils' times tables knowledge is at the expected level. Parents, guardians and carers are being asked to ensure that the children practise on Times Tables Rock Stars (TTRS) which will be of great benefit in preparing them for the Multiplication Tables Check. We suggest practising 10 to 15 minutes a day for optimal results.

Food Bank Visit - Year 6

As part of the Year 6 topic on global food crisis, Year 6 will be visiting the Hillingdon Foodbank in Uxbridge. Chestnut Class will be visiting on Tuesday 7th June whereas Oak Class will be visiting on Friday 10th June. You will have received a letter regarding the trip; please return the permission slip as soon as possible to authorise your child's attendance.

Fun Clubs - Group Two Begins

Please note that Group One of the fun clubs have now come to an end. Group Two will begin on the week commencing Monday 6th June; this club will run until Thursday 30th June.

Tudors Workshop - Year 5

On Thursday 9th June, Year 5 will take part in an interactive topic workshop. The workshops are being held to inspire an interest in the topics they have learnt. Most importantly, the children will garner first-hand experience about the topics through storytelling and drama. Please ensure that your child does not miss out on this engaging learning experience!

Advance Notice: Summer School

Hewens Primary School will be hosting an eight-day Summer School for pupils who are currently in Reception to Year 5. This will be held on **Monday 25th to Thursday 28th July and Monday 1st to Thursday 4th August** from 9:00am to 3:00pm. Unfortunately, we are not able to accommodate our current Nursery and Year 6 pupils.

Summer School will be free for pupils who are entitled to Free School Meals (parents, guardians and carers who receive this benefit from the government). If you wish for your child to take part and they are not entitled to Free School Meals, this will attract a cost of £5 per day. We will send out an electronic form via text message for you to complete if you wish for your child to participate.

No Smoking, Vaping and Use of Electronic Cigarettes
