The ducklings went on a tour around the School to visit each class and the children enjoyed welcoming the utterly beautiful and sweet-natured ducklings with cuddles.





Speech and Language Therapy

Parents, guardians and carers are invited to attend **four free online workshops via Zoom** with Speech and Language Therapists from the Mainstream Schools Team. The workshops are short, practical training sessions that will take place between Wednesday 20th and Wednesday 27th April on topics including Language, Social Communication, Selective Mutism and Reluctant Talkers, and Early Communication Skills.
