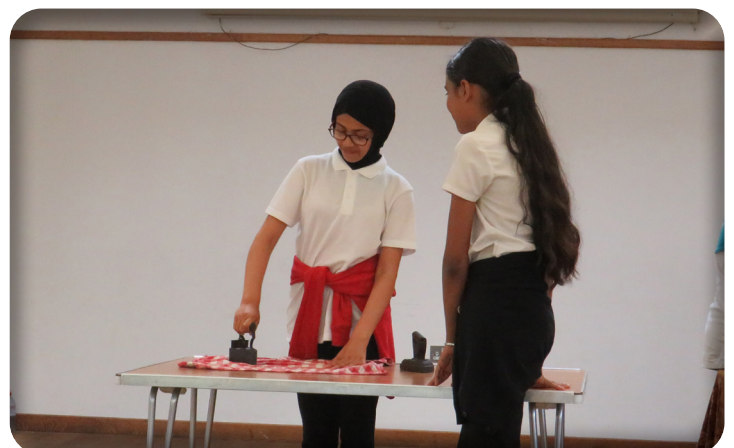




Museum of Farnham – Year 6 Trip
